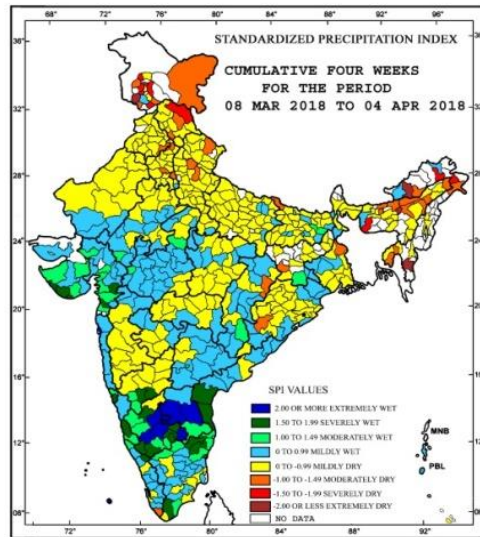


Standardised Precipitation Index Cumulative 4 weeks for the period 8th March to 4th April 2018

- Extremely/severely wet conditions experienced in few districts of Gujarat Region; Saurashtra, Kutch & Diu; Karnataka; Kowardha, Mahasamund, districts of Chhattisgarh; Vishakhapatnam, districts of Andhra Pradesh; Adilabad, districts of Telangana; Madurai, Namakkal, Pudukkottai, Trichy, Tiruvarur, Ariyalur, Karaikal, districts of TamilNadu & Puducherry; Cannur, Ernakulam, districts of Kerala.
- Extremely/Severely dry conditions experienced in few districts of Arunachal Pradesh; Himachal Pradesh; Cachar, Morigaon, districts of Assam; West Garo Hills, districts of Meghalaya; Ropar, Barnala, districts of Punjab; Baramula, districts of Jammu & Kashmir.
- Moderately dry conditions experienced in many districts of Tripura; Delhi; few districts of Arunachal Pradesh; Assam; Himachal Pradesh; Murshidabad, districts of West Bengal; Kalahandi, districts of Odisha; Garhwa, Ramgarh, districts of Jharkhand; Siddharth Nagar, Firozabad, Mainpuri, districts of Uttar Pradesh; Sirsa, districts of Haryana; Chamoli, Garhwal Tehri, districts of Uttarakhand; Moga, Sas Nagar Mohali, districts of Punjab; Bastar, districts of Chhattisgarh; Tumkur, districts of Karnataka.
- Rest of the country experienced moderately wet/mildly dry/mildly wet conditions.
