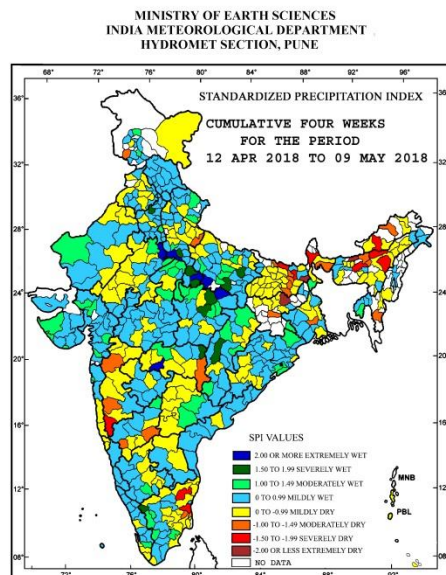


## Standardised Precipitation Index Cumulative 4 weeks for the period 12<sup>th</sup> April to 9<sup>th</sup> May 2018



- Extremely/severely wet conditions experienced in Allahabad, Azamgarh, Banda, Agra, Firozabad, Hamirpur, Jalaun, Mahoba districts of Uttar Pradesh; Kaithal district of Haryana; Bharatpur district of Rajasthan; Katni, Rewa, Satna districts of Madhya Pradesh; Gondia, Washim districts of Maharashtra; Durg district of Chhattisgarh; Nilgiri district of Tamil Nadu & Puducherry.
- Extremely/Severely dry conditions experienced in East Kameng district of Arunachal Pradesh; Kamrup, Karbi Anglong, Shonitpur, Baksa districts of Assam; Darjeeling district of West Bengal; Giridih district of Jharkhand; Katihar, Madhepura, Madhubani districts of Bihar; Kolhapur district of Maharashtra; Cuddalore, Tiruvannamalai districts of Tamil Nadu & Puducherry.
- Moderately dry conditions experienced in Upper Subansiri district of Arunachal Pradesh; Darrang, Udalguri districts of Assam; Lunglei district of Mizoram; Cooch Behar, Hooghly districts of West Bengal; Ranchi district of Jharkhand; Jamui, Khagaria, Monghyr, Saharsa, Sitamarhi districts of Bihar; Shahjahanpur district of Uttar Pradesh; Rajouri district of Jammu & Kashmir; Nashik, Satara, Gadchiroli districts of Maharashtra; Nagapattinam, Ariyalur districts of Tamil Nadu & Puducherry; Dharwad, Raichur districts of Karnataka.
- Rest of the country experienced moderately wet/mildly dry/mildly wet conditions.
