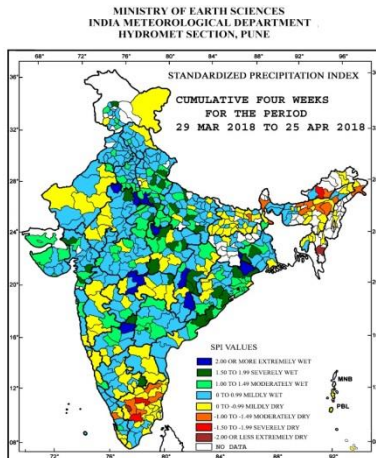


Standardised Precipitation Index Cumulative 4 weeks for the period 29th March to 25th April 2018



- Extremely/severely wet conditions experienced in Bankura district of West Bengal; Balasore, Ganjam, Keonjhar, Mayurbhanj, Kandhamal districts of Odisha; East Singhbhum, Seraikela-Khar districts of Jharkhand; Bhaich, Mirzapur, Pratapgarh, Unnao, Agra, Bareilly, Etawah, Firozabad, Mahamaya Nagar, Moradabad districts of Uttar Pradesh; Nainital district of Uttarakhand; Alwar, Bharatpur, Jhunjhunu districts of Rajasthan; Datia, Chhatarpur, Chhindwara, Katni, Shahdol, Tikamgarh districts of Madhya Pradesh; Narmada, Navsari, Patan districts of Gujarat Region; Mumbai Suburban district of Konkan & Goa; Amraoti, Gondia, Washim districts of Maharashtra; Bastar, Dhamtari, Durg, Raipur districts of Chhattisgarh; Vishakhapatnam, Vizianagaram districts of Andhra Pradesh; Hyderabad district of Telangana; Bidar, Gulbarga, Kolar districts of Karnataka.
- Extremely/Severely dry conditions experienced in East Kameng district of Arunachal Pradesh; Lunglei district of Mizoram; Dindigul, Salem, Tirupur districts of Tamil Nadu & Puducherry.
- Moderately dry conditions experienced in few districts of Arunachal Pradesh; Assam; Darjeeling, South Dinajpur districts of West Bengal; Madhepura district of Bihar; Erode, Karur, Vellore, Viluppuram districts of Tamil Nadu & Puducherry; Thrissur district of Kerala.
- Rest of the country experienced moderately wet/mildly dry/mildly wet conditions.
